# Camp Ceremonies Guide

## Opening Ceremony/Scouts Own— 29th July 2007

@ 6.00pm informally form up in front of your Groups camping area, carrying section flags and individual A5 flags (previous information provided). Band will parade around arena when it passes by your Group fall in behind and parade around (while band plays) waving your flags.

At a specific signal 'Whistle Blow x 3'. All will come to the alert, face the flag. 3 Flags on poles in the centre of the arena will be hoisted each by a Cub, Scout and Explorer. (World, Union and 2007). All invested members salute. Band will then move off again.

You will then be marshalled in front of the stage. Flag bearers will be directed to the stage to deposit flags. (These will not be collected formally).

Following the Opening Ceremony a brief 'Scouts own' will take place. Following this there will be a number of investitures taking place. Please let Julie Dixon or Simon Burgess know how many wish to be invested prior to the Ceremony.

All to wear Camp T Shirt and Group Scarf except those to be invested who should wear full uniform.

## Sunrise Ceremony— 1st August 2007

@ 7.45am prompt all campers and guests will form up around the arena as directed by marshals. @ 7.55 am the Ceremony Begins. Following Promises all will sit in place and watch Pageant. All should be in Full Uniform. Section flags are not required. Be prepared to join in and have fun.....

## Closing Ceremony— 3rd August 2007

All to complete 'Wishes Cards' by the end of the day on 2nd August and return them to Simon Burgess (these will be handed out on Sunday 29th). One wish should be selected per Group to be read out at the closing ceremony. (All cards will be placed in the time capsule).

@ 3.00pm all form up in full uniform within the main arena as instructed by marshals.

Following presentations and other speeches etc campers will be directed to witness the unveiling of a special commemorative stone marking the camp and the burying of a time capsule (if you have not supplied a name flash please get it to Simon Burgess ASAP). This will mark the official end of the camp.

All ceremonies orders may change due to local circumstances and/or weather conditions. We will inform you of changes.
