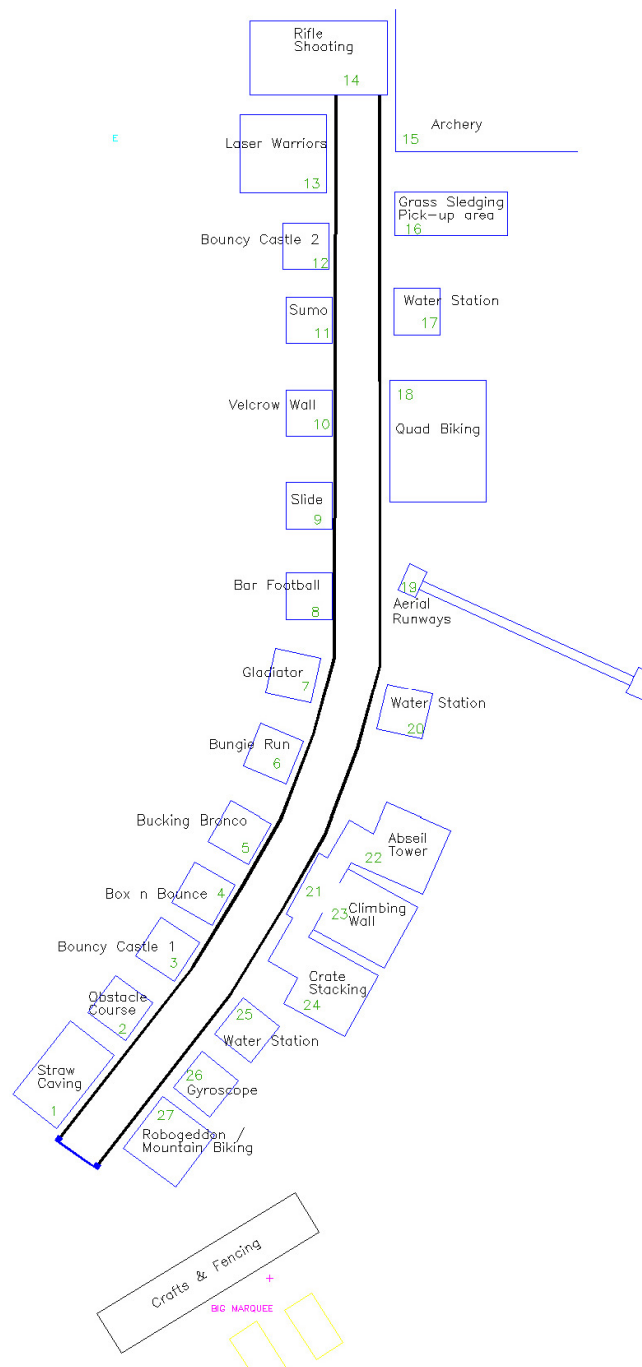

What, where & When?

The afternoon activities will run on Monday to Thursday at the following times:

Crafts

A large range of crafts will be running in the main marquee. Each time you complete a craft, your identity card will be stamped by a leader.
